



THE NAUTICAL INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

A Scholarship fund of £6,000 per annum has generously been donated anonymously to promote excellence in the broad field of nautical studies.

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide encouragement to individuals to develop their intellectual capacity, to advance the concepts of nautical science and maritime studies.

The scholarship is open to any UK citizen who is a voting member of The Nautical Institute, who is to undertake a course of study leading to a Master of Science qualification by examination at an institution of higher education in the UK in a marine related discipline. These terms are laid down by the donor of the fund.

Applicants fulfilling the above requirement should request an 'MSc Scholarship Scheme' application form from **The Nautical Institute, 202 Lambeth Road, London SE1 7LQ**. This application must be accompanied by an offer letter from the head of department/faculty confirming the course of study to be undertaken.

In the event of competition for this scholarship, the following factors will be taken into account: -

- (i) The applicant's case for scholarship funding (section F).
- (ii) The quality of the applicant's first degree and/or prior qualifications (section D & E).
- (iii) The originality and relevance of the applicant's ideas on projects which need to be studied (section G).
- (iv) The comments and references supplied e.g. from academic sources and employers.

Please note, the age limit for receiving the scholarship would normally be 45 years.
