Experienced Candidate Pathway

If you've identified yourself as an 'Experienced Candidate", you'll need to follow the adjacent flowchart to attain the Maritime Search and Rescue **Command Endorsement.**

Fees for the Interview and Certification are detailed in the fees section of the handbook.

¹ Powerboat: RYA Powerboat Level 2, Intermediate Powerboat, Advanced Powerboat, IYA International Powerboat Level 1 & Level 2, and all other nationality powerboat qualifications providing national states of qualification and assessment criteria can be verified.

Yachtmaster: RYA Yachtmaster Coastal, Offshore, Ocean, IYT Master of Yachts and all other nationality Yachtmaster equivalent qualifications providing national states of qualification and assessment criteria can be verified.

Master CoC: STCW recognised Master CoC (including limited CoCs).

Other qualifications: Naval/Coastguard/Military Command qualification issued by a recognised authority *or* hold an equivalent internal command gualification for your specific SAR organisation (endorsement will be limited to service on issuing organisation vessels only).

² SAR vessel or emergency response vessel with prescribed SAR responsibilities in SAR related tasks hours include SAR training hours at sea, SAR exercises at sea, and SAR service taskings.

³ Revalidated every 5 years subject to 60 hours approved sea hours onboard qualifying SAR vessel
