





They are designed to ensure that organisations and individuals receive essential in-depth knowledge to be able to operate competently and effectively. Courses are taught in small groups and take place both online and at locations around the world.



Navigation, Mooring and Cargo Assessor -Internal and External Assessor

The Navigation, Mooring and Cargo Assessors course offers candidates a chance to learn three different areas of assessment. 


















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
