

A FLEETWOOD SEMINAR: CASUALTY MANAGEMENT

Thursday 25th May 2023 1600h - 1830h

Building on the very successful leadership event at Fleetwood last year, we're now planning the next seminar. The objective are that, by the end of this event, participants will:

- be aware of the multiple issues that need to be addressed following a major incident at sea and
- have interacted with, and come to appreciate the role of, experts in various disciplines.

Schedule

- 1. 1600h Joint Engine/Deck Simulator Exercise (SimEx) involving 40 participants in the Simulators + 20 more observing in the debrief room.
 - The exercise involving a collision and ensuing casualty will be designed by the College and comprise the first part of the event.
- 2. 1630h The second and main component will be a comprehensive debrief/Q&A of the incident at each of four debriefing stations:
 - A. MCA/MAIB/Coastguard;
 - B. Casualty Investigation/Salvage;
 - C. Insurers/P&I/Law;
 - D. Shipowners and managers.

At each station there will be a panel of Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) coordinated by a named individual. It is anticipated that delegates and cadets will visit each of the stations to question the experts and learn from their experience during open discussions.

- 3. 1815h Plenary.
- 4. 1830h End
- 5. Social event (drinks and informal dinner) in Fleetwood. 1900h for 1930h.
