AMENDMENT TO GUIDELINES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF NAVIGATION-RELATED SYMBOLS, TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- The Sub-Committee on Safety of Navigation (NAV), at its fifty-fourth session (30 June to 4 July 2008), agreed on an addition to table 3 of the appendix of annex 1 of the Guidelines for the presentation of navigation-related symbols, terms and abbreviations (SN.1/Circ.243).
- This amendment introduces a new symbol for the presentation of an AIS Search and Rescue Transmitter (AIS-SART) as described in the performance standards given in resolution MSC.246(83).
- 3 The Maritime Safety Committee, at its eighty-fifth session (26 November to 5 December 2008), concurred with the Sub-Committee's views and approved the amendment to the Guidelines for the presentation of navigation-related symbols, terms and abbreviations, as set out at annex.
